

Beginners and old pros use Windows keyboards with Macs. Why making a perfectly good keyboard just because you switched platforms? Some people just prefer how the keys feel are those Apple deliveries. Any wired USB keyboard or Wireless Bluetooth-based keyboard will work well with the Mac. In fact, Apple even sells a Mac Mini without a keyboard or mouse. There's only one small problem with using a non-Apple keyboard: figuring out some of the keyboard equivalents. At least five keys have different names or symbols on the Windows keyboard than on the Mac keyboard, which can make it difficult to follow the instructions associated with the Mac. For example, a software guide might tell you to hold onto a command key (⌘) that appears to be missing from the Windows keyboard. He's there; it just looks a little different. Here are five of the most commonly used special keys on the Mac and their Windows keyboard equivalents. Mac Key Key Control Ctrl Option Alt Command (cloverleaf) Windows Removes Backspace Return Enter Use them to control a variety of Mac functions, including using Mac OS X launch labels. Another useful information for new Mac users is to know which key labels fit the keys on the keyboard. The characters used in the Mac menu can be a bit odd for those new to the Mac, as well as old hands that may be more mousers than keyboard users. In addition to Windows and Mac keyboards with slightly different names, they also change the positions of two commonly used modifier keys: Command and Option keys. If you're a longtime Mac user, switching to a Windows keyboard, the Windows key, which is equivalent to the Mac key, can occupy the physical position of the Option key on the Mac keyboard. It's also an alt-key Windows keyboard where you'd expect to find a Mac command key. If you're used to using the modifier keys with an old Mac keyboard, you'll probably be working in trouble for a while as you re-explore key locations. Instead of retraining key locations, use the keyboard in system preferences to reassign modifier keys. Running the Preference System by clicking on the icon in the dock, or clicking on the Apple menu on the left side of the bar menu, then selecting system preferences. In the System Preferences window that opens, select the keyboard preference bar. Click the Keys Modifier button. Use the pop-up menu next to Option and Command to select the action you want to do with the modifier keys. In this example, you want the Option Key (the Alt key on the Windows keyboard) to perform the Command, and the command key (the Windows key on the Windows keyboard) to perform Option. Don't worry, if it sounds a little confusing, it will make more sense when you see a drop down in front of you. Also, if something is a little mixed up, click the default Recovery button to put everything back as it was. Make changes and click OK and then close the system preferences. With C keys are remapped, you should not have any problems using any Windows keyboard with Mac. People new to the Mac but experienced by using shortcuts to speed up their workflow may be a little puzzled by the designations used in the Mac menu system to indicate when the key label is available. If the keyboard label is available for the menu item, the label will appear next to the menu item using the following notation: Key notation menu ^ Control ~ Option ⌘ Command ⌘ Delete ↵ Return or Enter ⇧ Shift When I was in the store to see how much it would cost for another piece of video equipment, in which case pop out of the reflector, I couldn't believe what I saw. \$300.00 for 3' diameter one! \$300.00!!!! A what!?!?! For a piece of reflective fabric and a little fish tape!?!?!? I could see all my beer money disappear when it came to me in no time... or maybe it was just a random reflection from one of the reflectors on the wall... Meh! that ever ... And so I was born..... Pop out reflectors are nothing more than fabric, 2 tape and some fish ribbons. What is the fish tape you are asking? This is a flat spring steel, which electricians use for fish wires behind walls. You can buy 25' roll stuff for 15 bucks. Tools: -Clothing machine -Pliers-Side incisors (in my case I used vice pens as there is a heavy cutter in the crotch of the mouth tool) -Scissors Raw: --For reflector of shiny fabric (you can also use white for less bounce light) I got a discount bin silver stuff for 3 dollars a yard and I got 2 yards - for the chrome key to get some kermit. -Roll fish tape (you can get this on HomeDepot) -Tie wires -2 Nylon edge tape -Thread needles and other consumables for the sewing machine Also here briefing for the lighting system I use, and LINK Full Build is covered in my podcast below during 6:28 and in MechanicalMashup.tv. You need to double-click the video to get it to play for some reason... Also some other ibles are mentioned in the first half. Was it one of yours? Ha! to get a movie to play on my computer I need to click on the movie once and hit the spacebar. I have no idea why clicking on the game doesn't work.... Ok this ible is painfully simple - Cut a rounded shape reflector or chrome key (I fold it twice with folds 90 degrees to each other and only cut once for a neat symmetrical shape, watch the video above if it doesn't make sense to you) - Sew one side of two nylon sewing tape to the fabric with half of it hanging over the edge - Fold again to make a tube To match the fish tape in leaving the gap at the end to put the fish tape in now through the gap you left in the ribbon loops to feed the fish tape through the tube. (Note you can make your life much easier by giving sharp angles from the end of the fish tape. on the other hand leave at least 3 inches overlap for the tape in front of you you him with side incisors. Next, use tie wires (you may be able to get away with tie wraps here I don't know, but it might be worth a try) to join the two ends of the fish tape as soon as you have the cloth taught, but not so taught that potato chips are a reflector or chrome key. If you associate it with 2 or three sections of tie the fish tape won't slip (at least so far for me). One thing to note is that it seems the maximum size for this kind of thing is about 5' x 3' after that they get pretty floppy. Sew closed the hole in the tape. Voila! Okay, well yes there are wrinkles, but as long as you don't care neither makes the light that it reflects. Think about it this way you pay 270.00 for the wrinkle-free version. I prefer to use these 270 for things like family feeding and beer or two. Also, yes, I know that there is a green key with a reflector mixed together in this ible ... I'm sure you can understand things. If you don't watch the video at the beginning at 6:28 time to understand things now, to fold their place with one hand on the side of the palm reflector to you and one palm from you and turn them together as if you are clapping, and it should roll neatly Here's a YouTube vid on how to do Apple hides a lot of additional information and useful options in the Mac menu. You can access these hidden options by holding the Option key. In some cases, you may need to hold the Option key before opening the menu. In other menus, you can press option while the menu is open and see how menu items change. Holding the Shift key while holding the Option key can reveal even more additional options in some menus. Use Move File Here and other options in Finder When you copy a file in a Mac search and move on to its insertion, it will create a copy

of the original There's no way to cut a file before you insert it to move it as it is on Windows and Linux. Instead, when you want to move a file, copy it normally. Then go to the folder you want to move it to, click the right button (or Control-click) and Option when the context menu is displayed. The usual menu item Insert item will become a Move item here. This works for many other menu items, too. Get the information becomes Shaw Inspector. Arrange By becomes Sort. Open in the new tab becomes open in the new window. A quick look becomes a Slideshow. Open with Becomes Always Open With. It also requires storing the Option key, but this time dragging the folder to another folder. A hidden merge button won't appear unless you hold the Option key. Use the additional app menu options Keep the option key when you press the app menu to find more options. For example, you can click on the app menu at the top of the screen and hold the option to see how Exit and Hold Windows. This closes the app, but your Mac will remember the windows it opened and reopen them. For example, if you edit a text file in TextEdit and then close it with the help of zuit and Keep Windows, TextEdit will automatically open that text file the next time you open it. You'll also find more options in the Windows menu. Minimize becomes Minimize Everything, Zoom Becomes To Zoom Everything, and Bring Everything to the Front Becomes Arrange in front. Depending on the app you use, you can see other options or just different options in its menu. Click option with an open menu to see if any menu items will change. Access information Click on Apple's menu and hold the Option key to see the Option option About this Mac become an option for System Information. The information box system offers much more detailed information than a simplified window about this Mac. Viewing Bluetooth Details should you see the state of your Mac Bluetooth equipment? Keep the Option key by clicking on the Bluetooth icon in the menu bar. (If you don't see this icon, you can turn it on from the system preference window. click the Bluetooth Settings icon and turn on the Bluetooth Show box at the menu bar.) You will see information about Bluetooth Mac hardware, including its Bluetooth device name and whether it is being discovered or not. Use more RELATED time machine options: How to back up your Mac time and recover files with The Time Machine Machine Menu icon also offers some advanced options when you hold the option key. Use Check Backup to allow your Mac to check any backups of the time machine on connected drives and make sure they are not damaged. Select View other backup drives to select another Time Machine backup drive connected to your computer, and files from him. It's not just a collection of individual things you can do. It's the way your Mac's interface works. If you've ever searched for an option or additional information, hold with Option the key while you click something. The option key even works while downloading the Mac - hold the Option key to select a download device, download a Windows system installed with Boot Camp, or download from a USB drive or other removable devices.
